It is our great pleasure to welcome you to Tokyo and Hiroshima during 23-27 March 2011 at the Tenth Jubilee International Symposium on Autonomous Decentralized Systems (ISADS 2011).

ISADS 2011 received 62 paper submissions for regular papers from all over the world. After peer-review process, we accepted 37 papers as regular papers with the acceptance rate of 59.7%. These papers will be presented in 10 technical sessions of oral presentations. In addition, ISADS 2011 received 10 paper submissions for poster papers. We accepted 16 poster papers from both submissions of poster and regular papers.

In addition to regular and poster sessions, the ISADS 2011 program committee put together an outstanding program. ISADS 2011 have four special sessions and 2 workshops. The special sessions consist of invited papers and their topics include Embedded System, Outstanding Researches in China, Outstanding Researches in Emerging Countries, and Network Software.

The workshops are AHSP and ADSN. AHSP is a one-day workshop and focuses on ad hoc, sensor, and P2P networks held at Shibaura Institute of Technology, Tokyo. ADSN is a two-day workshop and focuses on assurance technology and new generation networks held in Hiroshima City University, Hiroshima.

The ISADS 2011 program brings a wide set of vision, practices, and technical expertise to attendees covering both fundamental and new emerging advances in both ICT and industry areas.
